***Universal Unveils New Online Services at NBAA2007***

  - **Airport Lookup** – Immediate access to an online preview of UVTripPlanner<sup>sm</sup> business aviation data, featuring pre-flight planning tools including handlers and fuel resources.
  - **Destination Alerts** – Provides key security and weather information that could impact business aviation trips. Available in the Route Planning and Airport-to-Airport look-up feature at [www.universalweather.com](http://www.universalweather.com).
